Bardot's Búzios

What: Beachfront house, about 8,500 square feet, with six bedrooms and six and a half bathrooms, on a quarter of an acre
Where: Búzios, Brazil, 105 miles northeast of Rio de Janeiro

Amenities: Oceanfront swimming pool, pool house, boat garage

Asking Price: \$2 million.

Due Diligence: This two-story, wood-and-glass villa was built in 2002. The home has an eat-in kitchen, a media room and is being sold furnished. The pool house, with a traditional-style sape grass roof, also includes staff quarters with three bedrooms. French sex symbol Brigitte Bardot visited Búzios in the 1960s, putting the tiny peninsula on the map and turning it into an international resort. A popular destination for French, Chilean and Argentinean vacationers, Búzios has seen an increase in residential and commercial development in the past 10 years, thanks to a repaved highway to Rio. The nightlife and restaurant scene—centered on the roughly quarter-mile Rua das Pedras—is busiest from December to February, the high season, but the weather is mild most of the year.
